 is expected the plaque will be installed later in the year;
- Survey was carried out across the Estate by the Committee members (speedbumps, car-parking spaces, CCTV) results of which were published on VPE website under minutes section;
- Walk around the Estate (members of the Council attended) was carried out. Summary of the report was published on VPE website under minutes section:
- Recycling improvements the Committee members have been in touch with the Council. A Council representative may be able to be present at the summer party with a stall to raise awareness about recycling.
 Virginia created a recycling game to be added to the website. New posters on the bins are to be designed in the future.

Part 2 - All-Residents' Meeting

- 1. Approval of Minutes of 19th Feb 2019

 slabs (York stone replaced with concrete slabs), bin door locks
 jammed; concrete steps going to the flats damaged.
- It was suggested that the Heritage Lottery Fund could be a source of funding for some of the maintenance issues (erosion of bricks, original lighting to be restored).
