- 3. Financial update
  - Current balance: £577.74.
  - Community participation grant pending (£250.00).

5. Estate survey update (CCTV, speed bumps & marked car parking space)

- A survey was carried out by the committee members across the Estate. A
  leaflet was left though the letterboxes for the residents unavailable on the
  day of the survey.
- Total responses: 60

Car park spaces: 82% support or don't mind; 32% object

Speed bumps: 69% support or don't mind; 14% object

CCTV: 81% support or don't mind; 18% object. Due to lack of funds council would not be able to support CCTV installation and its maintenance.
