Estate Management Updates

- 1. Westcombe Court
 - Residents in Westcombe Court have received notification of further planning applications. Planning not communicated to other residents, AW to put link on WhatsApp group so that all residents can view plans if wanted
 - Concerns that they might be including plans for another mast in the planning application
 - Caretaking not satisfactory Westcombe court lifts cleaned badly, stairs not swept, Graffiti not cleaned off, litter not picked up. Only one lift working at a time for 8 months. EG notified caretaking staff of broken glass by the bus stop on Westcombe Park Road 3 times and it has still not been cleaned.
 - LT to email Cary Gay & others to follow up conversation that was had with her about improving maintenance in Westcombe court
- 2. Combe Mews
 - Further leak underneath that had been fixed but may have returned
- 3. Garages
 - Concerns about rats in garages along Westcombe Park Road, LC contacted caretakers who are trying to resolve
